Job Description

The selected candidates must permanently reside in the greater Charlotte area. The project manager will be responsible for all aspects of the solar system planning and installation. The PM will be physically involved in the actual installation of the systems and expected to be present on site. As a project manager, you will be dealing with our interconnections, permitting, engineering and design teams. You will be responsible for checking equipment, overseeing the installation, commissioning the system and being a liaison to the customer. You will be responsible for coordinating and managing our contract partners and installation teams. You will represent the image and ideals of NC Solar Now.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for managing all aspects of the installation of solar systems ranging from 1-50kW in size
- Responsible for managing the installation crews including roofers, electricians, and any other subcontractors as necessary
- Collaborate with our engineers and designers to refine system designs and ensure optimal design and installation practice before and during the installation as necessary
- Be the main point of contact with customers during and often after the installation
- Be fluent in solar technology and competent to discuss with customers, contractors, and potential leads
- Efficiently manage company resources (manpower, equipment, materials, time)
- Ensure all project documentation is organized and completed as required
- Adhere to OSHA safety standards as well as company policy
- Dealing with permitting and inspection departments

Requirements:

Initial Training and Orientation:

- The candidate will be expected to attend monthly meetings in person in Raleigh until both parties are confident in the candidate's ability to operate independently.
